EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATION, VET REGS, APPEDIX VI

All horse for which an FEI passport, or a National Passport approved by the FEI, has been issued, must have the vaccinations section endorsed by a veterinarian, stating that it has received two injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza, given between 1 and 3 months apart. In addition, a booster injection must be recorded as having been given within each succeeding 6 months, subsequent to the second injection of the primary vaccination. A booster must have been given within 6 months of the competition. None of these injections must have been given within the preceding 7 days, including the day of the competition or entry into the competition stables. These are the minimum requirements for influenza vaccination. Both primary and first and subsequent booster injections should be given according to the manufacturer's instructions which will fall within the stipulation of the FEI ruling.

From Veterinary Inspection, until the finish of the CRI competition all horses competing in FEI Class may not leave their stables without the prior permission of the FEI Steward. The stable log must then be completed whenever the horse is out of its stable, for exercise, grazing, farrier etc., except when at an FEI jog and inspection, posted warm up periods or whilst showing in the FEI competition. **At all times the horse's back number must be visible.**

Please ensure copies of passports and vaccination records are submitted with the entry form
