**British Reining Classes** owners and exhibitors must be members of British Reining. If horses do not have an NRHA Competition Licence they will need to apply for a BR one For further details on British Reining please see the website [www.britishreining.co.uk](http://www.britishreining.co.uk). **NRHA Classes** Exhibitors and owners must be members of NRHA and horses must have an NRHA Competition Licence. All classes are jackpot. NRHA website [www.nrha.com](http://www.nrha.com)

## Show conditions for qualifying events for the World Reining Championship

Competition open to the NRHA Affiliates and/or National federations members all over the world. Riders and owners must be current NRHA members, horses must have a NRHA competition license. For all the categories, the horses must be 5 years old and over. Qualification period is from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024. It is the rider who qualifies, and the horse ridden during the qualification does not necessarily have to be the one that will take part in the World Reining Championship 2025, although the minimum score for each category must be achieved.

- 68 for Junior riders
- 70 for Young riders
- 70 for Senior Amateur riders
- 71 for Senior Open riders

All riders who have participated and obtained the minimum score will be listed and awarded at the end of the year.

Each rider can participate in as many WR classes as they wish. They can also participate in events abroad.

Each rider will be able to enter the number of horses that the NRHA class authorizes.

Each nation will make its final selection of teams and individual riders for the World Reining Championship 2024.

**Stabling** Cost of **stable £50** including straw, if you require shavings please either bring your own or be prepared to purchase them at the show £10 per bale. Stables must be booked and paid for by April 8. Stabling is limited and early booking is advised. Priority will be given to horses competing.

**Office Fee** - is a Compulsory fee of **£10 per horse** regardless whether it enters a class or not.

**Drug test fee** is a compulsory **£10** per horse entered.

**Refunds** Any fees refunded will have 10% deducted for administration costs. Any fees not settled by the end of the show will be subject to a 10% surcharge. Any Stables and electric hookups cancelled after the cut-off date of April 8 will not be refunded unless they can be resold, and the admin fee will still be charged.

**Electricity Hookups @ £50** for the duration please book and pay in advance to secure your hook up these are strictly limited.
